



## **Jarden Consumer Solutions Employees in McMinnville Help Four Local Charities**

- **CHEER Mental Health Association** will receive a grant of \$1,620 to provide for the costs related to the organization's Parenting Support Group.
- **Kids of the Community** will receive a \$5,000 grant to purchase holiday gifts for at-risk youth in its programs.
- **Morrison Ruritan Club** will receive a \$5,000 grant to provide for the costs related to the food boxes it distributes, as well as to fund college scholarships for high school students.
- **Warren County Home Delivery Meals** will receive a \$5,000 grant to provide food for the homebound — approximately 1,300 meals.

The Jarden Consumer Solutions Community Fund is the Company's employee-funded charitable giving entity. As a 501(c)(3) organization, the Community Fund provides monetary grants to qualified charitable organizations that engage in community development initiatives (focusing on at-risk women, families and youth, and food programs) that serve the communities where JCS employees live and work.
